- The second ever Relais & Châteaux hotel now part of 580 landmark hotels and restaurants
- **Brand-new eco-treehouse** home to the Beehive kids club. The treehouse is built almost entirely of timber the world's most sustainable resource. It is carbon neutral, highly weather resistant and the wood smells amazing!
- Located on the edge of the New Forest in Hampshire on 130 picturesque acres of woodland, gardens, and parkland also a short walk from the beach and sea at Highcliffe-on-Sea.
- Chewton Glen's signature Treehouse Suites were opened in 2012 by Olympian Ben Ainsley and are complete with wrap around balconies, floor to ceiling windows, hot tubs, log burners. Guests receive breakfast hampers delivered silently by buggy each morning through a secret hatch.
- The largest and most secluded Treehouse "The Yews" sleeps up to 12 guests.
- Colonel George Marryat purchased Chewton Glen in the 1800's and his younger brother Captain Frederick Marryat used his visits to write the famous children's novel 'The Children of the New Forest'. Many of the rooms in the hotel today are named after Captain Frederick Marryat's novel and characters.
- The stream that flows through the grounds of Chewton Glen was once popular with smugglers taking their
 contraband into the New Forest. The border between Dorset and Hampshire also follows the path of the stream.
 The stream is also the county border between Dorset and Hampshire so you can sleep in Hampshire and play
 tennis in Dorset.
- In 1990 Chewton Glen opened the Chewton Glen Spa, the first of its kind in the UK with the UK's largest hydrotherapy spa pool, 17-metre swimming pool, outdoor whirlpool, cold drench showers, state-of-the-art gymnasium, dance studio with daily programme of classes, 9-hole par-3 golf course, indoor and outdoor tennis centre and acres of woodland jogging and walking trails.



- The award-winning Dining Room restaurant is a nexus of beautiful conservatories and intimate dining spaces. The connecting wine room has the largest number of wines from the UK on its wine list.
- The Kitchen offers casual dining and learning about food with its James Martin cookery school. Classes include "A Taste of Hampshire" and "Curries of The World". Junior chef classes for ages 6-17 are also available.
- Chewton Glen's 70 beehives are home to five million bees who produce honey for the hotel. The bonus is they pollinate the beautiful wildflowers surrounding the house. Guests can buy honey in the boutique, alongside homemade chutneys, jams, and jellies made by resident forager Jennifer Williams.
- The Orchard is home to over 200 heritage fruit trees and the grounds have over 158 varieties of trees. All grounds operations are led by Estate Manager Darren Venables, who has been with the hotel since 1989.
- Chewton is the ideal hotel for cruise fans, located nearby Southampton's dock (where the Titanic left!)
- The Chewton Glen Spa & Body Collection is inspired by the hotel's natural surroundings. The flavours of Sea Salt & Water Mint and Cedar & Wild Berry reflect the coastal and woodland location. The products are all natural, vegan, and free from artificial fragrances, colourants, silicones, parabens, and sulphates.

CHEWTON GLEN is a five-red star privately-owned luxury country house hotel, located on the edge of the ancient New Forest National Park in Hampshire and just a few minutes' walk from the sea. A member of Relais & Châteaux, this family-friendly resort features an award-winning restaurant, world-class spa and leisure activities, luxurious accommodation and modern meeting facilities and a Children Club. The hotel has 72 individually designed bedrooms and suites including 14 tree-house suites, a nine-hole par three golf course, croquet lawn, indoor and outdoor tennis courts and a spa which has been voted the best in Europe and a purpose-built cookery school, bakery and informal restaurant opened in association with James Martin.
