## **Roydon Woods Nature Reserve**

This nature reserve is beautiful all year round – whenever you choose to visit, you're sure to be absorbed by the magic of this enchanting ancient woodland.

Approx. 9 miles | 23 minutes



# **Blashford Lakes Nature Reserve**

Created from flooded gravel pits, Blashford Lakes is now a bustling centre of activity, used by thousands of birds all year round including kingfisher, lapwing and oystercatcher.



Approx. 13 miles | 28 minutes

### Lymington and Keyhaven Marshes

This coastal reserve offers fantastic views across the Solent to Hurst Castle and the Isle of Wight.

Approx. 7 miles | 17 minutes



### **Bouldnor Forest Nature Reserve**

Bouldnor Forest is one of our Isle of Wight based sites with a prehistoric past. Boasting a variety of habitats, including pine forest, heathland, cliffs and seagrass beds.

Approx. 15 miles on the Ferry
